After making a presentation at the North American Society for Sport Management last summer, Dr. Jeff Noble has been continuing his research on how youth sport administrators perceive policy issues pertaining to sexual harassment and abuse of children.

Mike Ross is working with Dr. Jeff Noble and Dr. Clay Stoldt on a project describing how college athletics communicators perceive to be the primary advantages and disadvantages of social media. He is also working with Dr. Mark Vermillion on a project dealing with the use of technology and flexible learning environments by sport management students.

Having worked in collaboration with Dr. Martin Perline (Economics) and Dr. Mark Vermillion, Dr. Stoldt will be making a presentation at the NCAA Convention in January. He is also continuing his research on the impact of social media in college athletics.

Dr. Vermillion recently completed work on a book chapter he coauthored regarding deviance in sport. He is also preparing a presentation for the Midwest Sociological Society dealing with perceptions of moral character and sport participation.
