- Faculty-at-large are selected according to standard procedures for naming members to faculty senate commit ees, except that they shall be from di erent Faculty Senate divisions, and shall be full-me, tenured faculty members with the rank of associate professor or higher. Faculty-at-large serve three-year terms. Ex o cio and faculty at-large members may not serve while a candidate for promo on or incen ve review, or while on sabba cal leave.
- Replacement appointments shall be made as needed, following standard procedures.

Charges:

1. Implement university-wide policies and procedures for awarding tenure and promo on.

6. Review tenure and promo on cases in accordance with the University Tenure, Promo on, and Appeals Procedure.

7. Review every three years the college/school/University Libraries guidelines for tenure and promo on.

8. Report to the full Faculty Senate for review issues of concern in tenure policies and tenure and promo on guidelines.

The review commit ee at the University level-is composed of the same members as the Faculty Senate Tenure and Promo- on Commit-ee, with the excep- on that the two at-large tenured members will be replaced by two at-large non-tenure track faculty. is the NTT Promo on Commit ee, whose general charge is established in the Faculty Senate rules. No person may serve on the University-level review commit ee in a year in which he or she is considered for tenure or promo on."

If the commit ee discovers that informa on is lacking in a primary dossier, it can ask the Provost to acquire the informa on, which will be placed in the primary dossier. Consistent with college/school/University Libraries procedures the Provost must provide the candidate a copy of the material and allow the candidate to write a rebut al, which will also be placed in the primary dossier. The commit ee will then consider the cases before it, whether regular or appealed. The commit ee may request a writ en response from the dean on mat ers of interpreta on of evidence, the academic needs of the unit, or its current resources, but the commit ee will not invite the dean or other outside persons to meet with the commit ee. Consistent with college/school/University Libraries procedures, the candidate shall be provided a copy of any addi onal writ en material provided to the commit ee and shall be provided an opportunity to write a rebut al. Both the statement and the rebut al will be placed in the primary dossier. Straw ballots may be taken, but these are neither binding nor recorded. Absten ons will not be registered except when a faculty member on a commit ee declares he/she has a conflict of interest concerning a case.
