Some senators spoke in support of the new degree while others questioned creating a new major now as well as the funding and the new hire. Dean Hippiisley noted that the course fee would pay for adjuncts while the new hire would be new money, but the case would be made to KBOR that there is a real demand for ASL interpreting in south central Kansas. As to the monetary numbers, those were done by others on the committee proposing the program, and they will come back with specifics in the next meeting.</li> </ul>
