

## Koplik Memorial Scholarship

Deadline for Academic Year 2020-2021: October 30, 2020

The Koplik Memorial Scholarship awards a \$1,200 scholarship in honor of Dr. Stanley Z. Koplik, who served as Executive Director of the Kansas Board of Regents from 1982 until 1993, when he left to become Chancellor of the Massachusetts Board of Higher Education. Upon his untimely death in 2000, his family and friends established the scholarship to honor his service to the Kansas Board of Regents and the Regents institutions as well as his advocacy of accessible and affordable high-quality public education.

Applicants will be reviewed on the following:

1. Recipient of this scholarship shall be a junior or senior full-time student with a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Award is for the 2020-2021 academic year.
2. Applicants are requested to submit a five-hundred-word essay stating their educational goals and how the scholarship assistance would be important to them.
3. Applicants must demonstrate financial need. Please complete the 2020-2021 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) if you have not already done so.
4. Preference shall be given to Kansas residents.
5. The scholarship is to be used for tuition and/or other related educational expenses.
