Additional Graduation Requirements:


- 1) For all bachelor's degrees granted by WSU, at least 30 credit hours must be earned at WSU. In addition, at least 24 of the last 30 credit hours applied towards the degree must be completed at WSU.
- 2) WSU requires a minimum of 45 upper-division credit hours
- 3) WSU requires a minimum of 120 total hours to graduate. This includes any transferred hours from a regionally accredited school.
